Beckley Preschool is committed to promoting the health and well-being of children and staff through physical activity. This policy outlines the organisation, teaching and management of physical activity at both settings.

Ethos and Environment

Beckley Preschool strive to maximise opportunities for children and staff to be physically active by promoting all avenues for activity. This includes the curriculum, environment and wider community.

Physical activity aims and objectives

Aim; to ensure that all aspects of physical activity in the setting are promoted for the health and well-being of children, staff and visitors.

Our specific objectives are;

- to enable children and staff to understand the importance of physical activity through the provision of information and development of appropriate skills and attitudes
- to provide and promote opportunities for staff and children to be physically active throughout and beyond Preschool hours.
- To increase physical activity levels of children in line with National targets

All physical activities offered at Beckley Preschool are designed to be inclusive and cater for different ability levels.

Resource Provision

We have access to large indoor spaces equipped with portable apparatus for all forms of gymnastic play and games as well as a variety of outside areas.

Beckley Preschool has the use of a large space in the Main Hall during most sessions which is divided from the rest of the activities by wooden barriers. On days when the Preschool is in the Small hall there is some access to the open space of the large hall when it is free from other organisations who hire the Hall.

Beckley Preschool also has a small outside area which will soon be having an all weather surface and a small field with some permanent climbing structures.
