NATIONAL EMERGENCY PROCEDURE

Unfortunately due to past terrorist attacks, we now feel it is necessary to have a procedure in place on what to do in the event of a terrorist attack or a national disaster. We of course hope that this procedure never needs to be put into practice.

The care and security we provide for your child is our first priority. As an Ofsted Registered Pre-School, we will do everything within our power to protect, support and reassure your child in the event of a major incident, National Emergency or Terrorist Attack.

If we are involved or caught up in the incident, we will comply fully with the instructions from the emergency services and constantly reassure the children in our care.

If you are caught up in an incident, we will continue to look after your child until you are able to return, or a person nominated is able to collect them.

We will try our best to keep in contact by landline, mobile or email. We understand that during major incidents the mobile phone networks are often not available and even landlines can be cancelled to free up communication systems for the emergency services. We will however attempt to contact you on a regular basis and ask that you try to do the same. We will keep up to date on the situation using any media source available to us - tapestry, radio, television, internet etc.

We will always work to minimise any risk to your child in these circumstances. We will endeavor to protect your child from information or images that may alarm or distress them.

We are happy to discuss any issues you have.
